

Breckenridge Brewery opened its doors in 1990 in the mountain town of Breckenridge, Colorado. It's the third-oldest craft brewery in the state. Their portfolio contains classics like Vanilla Porter, Avalanche Amber Ale, Agave Wheat, 471 Double IPA, and Breck IPA, along with a variety of specialty beers that include seasonals, barrel-aged beers, the Brewery Lane Series, and a newly announced nitrogen-charged canned series. We look forward to sharing some of these beers with you this month!



#### **Avalanche Amber**

**Avalanche Amber** beer is a blend of pale and caramel malts — and just a kiss of bittering hops — to create a refreshing-but-flavorful, anytime beer. Aromas of pale grains, a semi-sweet middle and a clean-as-Colorado snow finish make this Breckenridge Brewery's best-selling beer. ABV 5%



### 471 Small Patch IPA

**471 IPA** is a small batch, limited edition ale created to separate the weak from the strong. 471 is a double IPA, that combines Pale, Munich, Caramel-30, Carapils and Torrified Wheat malts, with Chinook, Centennial, Simcoe and Fuggles hops. It has a big sweet mouthfeel, followed by more hoppiness than you've ever had at one time. ABV 9.2%



#### **Agave Wheat**

**Agave Wheat** complements the refreshingly light quality of Breckenridge wheat and adds a subtle note of flavor that expands this beer's uplifting taste profile. It is familiar, yet creative. ABV 4.2%



## **Christmas Ale**

The chill of a Colorado high-country winter calls for a beer with extra flavor and strength. Here it is. Breckenridge Brewery **Christmas Ale**. At over 7% alcohol, with a sturdy texture and rich flavors of caramel and chocolate, this holiday seasonal is the fermented equivalent of a good fire. ABV 7.1%



#### **Nitro Vanilla Porter**

Breckenridge Brewery puts a nitro spin on its delicious Vanilla Porter, **Nitro Vanilla Porter**. Infused with a combination of nitrogen and CO2 gases, this beer delivers a mellow, velvety version of Breckenridge Brewery's classic Vanilla Porter. A variety of malts provide flavors of chocolate, roasted nut, caramel, and coffee. Imported vanilla beans from Papua New Guinea and Madagascar add complex and exotic flavors to this solid porter. The softening effect of nitrogen creates a velvety mouthfeel and highlights the flavors of the malts and vanilla. ABV 5.4%
